## **The Axial Skeleton - Anatomy and Physiology Resources**

The axial skeleton includes the bones that form the skull, laryngeal skeleton, vertebral column, and thoracic cage. The bones of the appendicular skeleton (the limbs and girdles) “append” to the axial skeleton. 1. Skull Bones Protect the Brain and Form an Entrance to the Body. The skull consists of the cranial bones and the facial skeleton. The cranial bones compose the top and back of the skull and enclose the brain.
