The CIMC is the out-of-band management card of the physical UCS server hosting the APIC. You need to connect a console cable to APIC console port (not the CIMC port) and reboot the APIC (e.g. in CLI using command `acidiag reboot`). Check the screen with the different boot options, select F8 CIMC Configuration, and configure the IP Config of CIMC.

Dedicated - uses the "dedicated" M1 and M2 management interfaces for CIMC access. Single management IP configured, both ports can respond to the management IP. Shipping - Management Port is assigned a static IP of 10.1.1.7. Management Port 2 is configured for DHCP. Shared LOM - Assigns the CIMC management IP to the 1G LOM interfaces.

Hi there, I'm currently trying to set up my CIMC on APIC SERVER M2 and there is something "weird" while entering in CIMC utility. According to cisco documentation and several example on youtube, when we press F8 to enter in CIMC utility configuration, there is a window where we have to enter the default password.

It is always suggested to use CIMC for monitoring your Cisco rack-server, however you can use any SNMP tool to monitor the hardware components. SNMP uses MIBs to get the info from CIMC, below is contains info related to MIBs for CIMC and UCSM

In older version of CIMC, you can go to " Server -> Remote Presence -> Serial over LAN -> enable ". Remember to use COM0 & 9600bps, if you get it working with COM1, let me know. Note that by default they use port number 2400 and if you SSH to your CIMC IP address using port 2400, you will get WLC console access.

Download the ISO file `PI-APL-3.1.0.0.132-1-K9.iso` from cisco.com and verify file integrity using the checksum values listed for it on cisco.com. Note Ensure no storage devices are connected to the USB port of the appliance before upgrading or installing the ISO image.

To determine your APIC model, login to the CIMC and find the PID for your APIC Server, located on the Server > Summary Tab (This should be the main page you encounter on logging into your CIMC). APIC-SERVER S1/M1/L1 = UCS-C220 M3. APIC-SERVER S2/M2/L2 = UCS-C220 M4. SERVER > SUMMARY.
