The Foreskin and the Origins of Circumcision

Medicalised circumcision did not appear until the latter part of the nineteenth century, when some members of the American medical establishment began to believe that circumcision could cure such wide-ranging real and fictitious diseases as insanity, masturbation, epilepsy, paralysis, hernia, hip-joint disease, tuberculosis, cancer, venereal disease, and headache, to name just a few.

Circumcision was a common practice among the British middle and wealthy classes from the 1890s to at least the 1940s. Research showing protection against syphilis, penile cancer and the improvement in hygiene led to it becoming a widely recommended for hygienic and health reasons.
