Examples of medication names that look or sound similar to each other include hydralazine and hydroxyzine, Keflex and Keppra, metronidazole and metformin, Zyprexa and Zyrtec, and Actonel and Actos. At least one out of every 1,000 prescriptions in the United States is associated with a wrong-medication error, and name confusion is thought to be a key cause.

Reducing Errors from Look-Alike, Sound-Alike Medication ...

Here are a couple of recent reports involving look-alike and/or sound-alike drug names reported to the Institute for Safe Medication Practices Medication Errors Reporting Program (ISMP MERP). The Table lists the confused drug names reported to the ISMP MERP from July through September 2010. Valtrex (valACYclovir) and Valcyte (valGANciclovir).

Look-Alike, Sound-Alike Drug Names

The Medicines & Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) issued advice for healthcare professionals in early 2018 to be extra vigilant when prescribing/dispensing items that could potentially be confused with another due to similar looking/sounding names (both brand and generic).

Look-alike sound-alike (LASA) items

In 2010, the look-alike/sound-alike requirement (NPSG.02.02.01) was moved to the standards and can be found at Medication Management standard MM.01.02.01, EP 1: The hospital develops a list of look-alike/sound-alike medications it stores, dispenses, or administers.

Sound Alike / Look Alike (SALA or LASA) Drugs

The Institute for Safe Medication Practices Canada (ISMP Canada) recommends a number of risk-reduction strategies for look-alike sound-alike (LASA) drugs. Examples of strategies which centres could adopt to differentiate between Herceptin® and Kadcyla® (or other LASA drugs) are listed in the chart below.

The term SALADs (Sound-Alike Look-Alike Drugs) refers to look-alike and sound-alike drug names and look-alike product packaging which can cause confusion resulting in potentially harmful medication errors.
