According to a Social Science Research Council study, 24% of children living in rural areas live in poverty, compared to 20% of children in urban areas. More than 20% of youth living in rural areas are “disconnected,” meaning they are neither employed nor attending school.

This especially relates to rural schools, as rural areas are more likely to experience poverty, according to the Center for Public Education. For example, rural counties are 17 percent more likely to experience poverty, and rural families are more likely to fall into “deep poverty,” marked at less than half of the national poverty level.

Poverty cannot be eradicated without addressing the pervasive inequalities in incomes and economic opportunities between and within countries, between rural and urban areas, and between men and women. Reducing such inequalities will need to start with improving access for the poor to productive resources, basic services and social protection.

Students in rural areas can have limited access to coursework, healthcare, and employment opportunities, and face higher levels of poverty compared to children living in suburban or urban areas. Additionally, rural school districts face challenges like limited funding as well as having to serve students across large geographic areas.

### Rural Populations - American Youth Policy Forum

Rural youth may lack important skills and resources to be competitive in formal labour markets, both in rural areas of origin and urban areas of destination. They have insufficient economic assets, savings and human capital, social capital (i.e. the ability to make use of networks) and cultural capital (i.e. language, customs) (WB, 2011b).
