He then dismissed the crowd and went up a mountain by himself to pray.

## **Walking on water - Miracles of Jesus**

Answer: One of Jesus Christ's most instructive miracles takes place when the apostle Peter jumps out of a boat and walks on turbulent water to meet the Lord on the sea. The account, which follows on the heels of another illuminating miracle, the feeding of the 5,000, is recorded in Matthew 14:22-36. Not only does Jesus walk on the Sea of Galilee here, but Peter walks on the water as well.

## **What can we learn from the account of Peter walking on water?**

He approached the distressed disciples in an entirely unexpected way, by walking on the turbulent sea as if it were stable as rock. Clearly, He had been praying for and watching out for them while on the mountain, but when He passed near them, they did not recognize their Savior.

Answer: The miracle of Jesus walking on the water, recorded in three of the Gospels ( Matthew 14:22-36; Mark 6:45-56; John 6:16-21 ), came on the heels of His miraculous feeding of the 5,000 with only five loaves of bread and two fish ( Matthew 14:17 ). But it was the miracle of Jesus walking on the water that, more than any other, convinced Jesus’ disciples that He was indeed the Son of God ( Matthew 14:32-33 ).

## **What was the meaning of Jesus walking on water ...**

The account happens after Jesus fed five thousand men (and another ten to fifteen thousand children and women), another powerful miracle that skyrocketed His influence. After the account, He sent the disciples ahead to sail across the Sea of Galilee.

## **4 things we can learn from Jesus walking on water**

Jesus invites Peter to come walk on the water with him. Peter climbs out of the boat and begins to walk on the water to Jesus. As soon as Peter gets scared of the wind and waves and takes his eyes off Jesus he begins to sink. Jesus reaches his hand down and grabs Peter.
